Cell Phones & Rental Cars

When you plug your cellphone into the rental car's infotainment system, it may store all your personal information and keep locations you entered into the GPS or visited while traveling in the car. It may store phone numbers, calls, messages, contacts, and texts.

Unless you delete the data before you return the car, rental agents and future renters can access your data.

Go to the infotainment's system's setting menu to find a list of devices that have paired with the system. Locate your device and follow the prompts to delete them.

XCEL Energy Warns of Fraudulent Calls

Wes Reeves of XCEL Energy is warning customers of fraudulent callers trying to coerce personal and financial information from individuals to be used in identity theft crimes.

"The caller tells customers that their power is about to be disconnected if a payment is not made over the phone to cover a past due balance."

Reeves offers red flags such as "if the callback number is not a published Xcel Energy customer support phone number or the caller demands payments be made in prepaid debit cards or refuses to provide options for payment.

Innocuous information like birthdays, addresses, maiden names or family members' names can lead to financial chaos.

Call 1-800-829-1040 to double check if the caller is truly from the IRS. For more information, go to <IRSimposterscamsinfographic>.

Andrew Johnson of the Consumer & Business Education FTC, says the IRS will first contact you by mail. They will not demand that you pay right away. They will not tell you to use a specific form of payment.

Always double check rather than give away personal information or debit card information.

Texas Retirement System's Board of Trustees Met to Stem Multimillion \$ Shortfall (from FAQs: TRS Care Changes)

Retirees will not face an increase in medical premiums. Benefits and premiums for the TRS-Care Medicare Advantage Plans will not change either. Rather, there will be increases in pharmacy co-pays, in medical deductibles, and maximum out-of-pocket limits. Changes were made to keep TRS-Care afloat through 2017.
