TRTF is a non-profit organization that works to provide resources for retired TRS annuitants, as well as active and beginning teachers. We are the charitable partner organization of TRTA.

What We Do

We help educators of the past, present and future by supporting four charitable programs, an educational program, and an endowment fund:

- * Beginning Teacher Scholarships for first-year educators
- Classroom Assistance Grants for current educators to assist with classroom projects
 - "A Helping Hand" for retired school personnel who need financial assistance
- Disaster Relief Fund for retirees and active educators struggling financially after natural disasters in Texas (such as hurricanes)
- The Legacy Campaign to promote a positive image of public education in Texas and provide resources for educators of all generations to connect with another and learn about TRS
- The Lehr-Pritchard Endowment Fund to raise funds in honor of the 25th anniversary of the CPI Catch-Up Plan, led in part by former TRTA Executive Director and TRTF Trustee Mike Lehr.
