Beginning Teacher Scholarship Guidelines: 2022-2023 *"Supporting Public Education in Texas"*

Beginning Teacher Scholarship Application Process:

The Beginning Teacher Scholarship is intended to reimburse an applicant for certification tests and test results, and to provide money to help the applicant purchase materials for the classroom for his or her first year of teaching. The Texas Retired Teachers Foundation (TRTF) will award 20 \$750 scholarships for the 2022-2023 school year to candidates who are referred by an active member of the Texas Retired Teachers Association (TRTA), have earned or are earning an undergraduate or master's degree at a Texas university or college, and have taken or are planning to take their teaching certification exam or pursuing alternative certification. Applicants may download the application from the TRTF website at <u>www.trtf.org</u> beginning September 17, 2021. All applications must be *received in full* by 5:00 pm on Friday, February 25, 2022. Applications received after the deadline will not be considered.

Scholarship Applicant Eligibility:

An applicant must:

1. have taken or be scheduled to take a Texas teacher certification exam(s) in 2021 in preparation to begin teaching in the fall of 2022 or spring of 2023.

2. be referred by an active member of the Texas Retired Teachers Association (TRTA).

3. have earned an undergraduate or master's degree and a teacher's certification or alternative certification by August 31, 2022.

4. submit his or her application and legible college transcripts by 5:00 p.m. on February 25, 2022.

How to Apply for a TRTF Student Scholarship:

- 1. Download the application at **<u>www.trtf.org</u>**.
- 2. Complete and submit the application by email (sarah@trta.org) or U.S. Mail.
- 3. The application and required documents must be received no later than 5:00 pm on February 25, 2022.

Scholarship Application Review:

The TRTF Scholarship Review Committee will review all scholarship applications competitively.

Notification of Scholarship Recipients:

The names of the twenty 2022-2023 TRTF scholarship recipients will be announced on Wednesday, April 13, 2022. Winners will be notified by telephone and/or e-mail. <u>PLEASE NOTE</u>: Recipients must have fulfilled all requirements for certification to become a teacher in Texas and submit proof of certification completion before receiving scholarship funds, as well as proof of employment with a Texas school district for the fall 2022 or spring 2023 semester.

Texas Retired Teachers Foundation Beginning Teacher Scholarship Application: 2022-2023

Guidelines:

Students must have taken or be scheduled to take the Texas teacher certification exam in 2021 or have completed an alternative certification in anticipation of beginning their teaching career during the fall of 2022 or spring of 2023. Applicant must have an undergraduate or master's degree by August 31, 2022 and be referred by an active member of the Texas Retired Teachers Association (TRTA). Applicants must submit a transcript from his or her college or university demonstrating completion or projected completion of degree program. Deadline for submitting *completed* applications, including transcripts, is February 25, 2022 by 5:00 pm. <u>Note</u>: Recipients must submit proof of graduation and certification before receiving scholarship funds, as well as proof of employment with a Texas school district.
