Students will receive not only excellent educational support but will also engage on a multi-generational level that improves interpersonal skills when they receive tutoring services from a Texas retired teacher.



TRTA's membership numbers at the end of the 2021 membership year were just over 80,000. We all know that there is power in numbers, and TRTA is working across the state to make that number grow to 100,000 strong this year.

This year several rewards have been instituted to get members involved in recruiting new members. First, at the State level, "Bracket Awards" for the different sized local units were given for the highest percentage of growth from September 2020 to July 2021. (MASRA did not win that \$500 for our bracket.) TRTA continues its "Each One Bring One" campaign where each member recruiting a new member will have their name entered in a drawing for \$100. District 10 is rewarding a Unit \$50 per quarter in each bracket for the most membership growth in the "Reach for the Stars" initiative. The third quarter begins in September. The Unit with the largest number of new/renewing members (in our bracket size), October 1, 2021 – May 31, 2022, will be recognized by District 10 as well. Finally, MASRA will present any member who recruits two members with a cup of coffee (gift card) from Starbucks. Senate Bill 7 and House Bill 5

Senate Bill 7 provides for a one time supplemental payment for Texas public education retirees who retired before December 31, 2020, not to exceed \$2,400. This bill has been approved by the Texas House Representatives and already approved by the Texas Senate.

House Bill 5 provides funds of 701 million dollars for the supplemental payments to retirees. The payment will not come from TRS pension fund. This bill still has not been approved by the House.

The last step of the legislative process is approval of Senate Bill 7 and House Bill 5 by Governor Abbott.

Thank you MASRA members for communicating with legislators for the passage of Senate Bill 7 and House Bill 5. I personally feel public education retirees will get approval for a 13<sup>th</sup> check.
