Classroom Assistance Grant Guidelines: 2023-2024
"Supporting Public Education in Texas"

Grant Application Process:

Classroom Assistance Grants are awarded to Texas public school teachers who, on a daily basis, demonstrate commitment to public education and Texas children through the creation of programs, events, or other learning platforms.

The Texas Retired Teachers Foundation (TRTF) will award 30 \$750 grants to 30 public school teachers in Texas for the 2023-2024 school year. Applicants may download the application from the TRTF website at www.trtf.org beginning September 16, 2022. All applications must be *received* by 5:00 pm on Friday, January 27, 2023. Applications received after the deadline will not be considered.

Applicants may apply individually, as a group/team or as a school. If you apply as a group/team or as a school, please designate someone to lead your grant application process and serve as the contact person to receive any related correspondence from the Foundation.

Classroom Assistance Grant Eligibility:

- 1. Applicants must be public school teachers for the 2023-2024 school year who pay into the Teacher Retirement System of Texas (TRS).
- 2. All applications must include a *handwritten* signature of the school principal expressing approval of the project.

How to Apply for a Grant:

- Download the application at <u>www.trtf.org</u>.
- 2. Complete and submit the application by scanning and e-mailing (sarah@trta.org) or by U. S. Mail.
- 3. The application and required documents must be received no later than 5:00 pm on January 27, 2023.

Grant Application Review:

The TRTF Grant Review Committee will review all grant applications competitively.

Notification of Grant Recipients:

The names of the thirty grant recipients will be announced on March 31, 2023, via email, the TRTF website, and Facebook. Recipients may be asked to participate in a survey or video after receiving the grant money.
