The Texas Retired Teachers Foundation (TRTF) is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit that works to provide resources for retired TRS annuitants, as well as active school personnel.



GRANTS & SCHOLARSHIPS

The Classroom Assistance Grant is awarded to public-school teachers, librarians, coaches and more who demonstrate daily commitment to public education and Texas children through the creation of programs, events, or other learning platforms. Since 2008, TRTF has awarded more than \$177,000 in grants.

The First-Year Teacher Scholarship is to provide funds to assist the recipient in purchasing materials for his or her classroom. Since 2008, TRTF has awarded more than \$155,250 in scholarships.

"A HELPING HAND" & DISASTER RELIEF

"A Helping Hand," which was launched in 2010, provides public education retirees with charitable assistance for a one-time special need or short-term hardship. Recipients include anyone who is receiving an annuity from the Teacher Retirement System of Texas (TRS). Since its inception, "A Helping Hand" has awarded more than \$240,000 in financial assistance for medical bills, home and auto repairs, groceries, and utility bills.

The Disaster Relief Program has awarded more than \$375,000 to 1,100 active and retired school employees to repair damage to homes caused by flooding, burst pipes, and leaking roofs.
